

## **Bugbrooke Community Lottery**



### **Terms and Conditions**

**Purpose:** The purpose of the lottery is to raise money in support of good causes in the village of Bugbrooke.

**Organiser Details:** The lottery will be run by the Bugbrooke Community Lottery committee. The promotor of the lottery is Chris Carter, 27 Pilgrims Lane, Bugbrooke, Northampton, NN7 3PJ.

**Eligibility:** The lottery is open to all residents of the UK who are 18 years of age or over.

**Tickets:** Tickets will be sold at £2 per ticket and can be purchased either by registering online at the Bugbrooke Community Lottery website ([www.playbcl.org](http://www.playbcl.org)) or in cash. All tickets purchased are non-refundable.

**Prizes:** The aim is to allocate 50% of tickets sales (after the deduction of costs) to prizes ("the prize fund"). The value of prizes will be reviewed quarterly and will be dependent on ticket sales in the preceding quarter. Prizes will be allocated to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> tickets drawn with 50% of the prize fund allocated to as 1<sup>st</sup> prize, 30% as 2<sup>nd</sup> and 20% as 3<sup>rd</sup>.

In the event that the prize fund falls below the 50% of income target, the prize fund for the December draw will be increased in order to reach the 50% target for the calendar year.

**Draw:** The draw will take place on the 27<sup>th</sup> of each month and will be broadcast live on the Bugbrooke Community Lottery website. The winning tickets will be selected at random using a random number generator.

**Winner notification:** Winners will be contacted within 3 days by either telephone or email. A list of the winners will be posted on the Bugbrooke Community Lottery website and Facebook page.

**Payment of Prizes:** Winners will be paid by either bank transfer or by cheque. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed in the Bugbrooke Community Lottery funds after 6 months. If after issuing a cheque it remains uncashed 6 months after the date of issue, the cheque will be cancelled and the funds will be placed in the Lottery Funds.

**Online Purchases:** For tickets purchased via the website the following conditions apply:

The buyer can purchase either a regular monthly subscription to the draw or a one-off entry.

Tickets can be purchased until midnight on the day preceding the draw.

No refunds can be offered.

Buyers will **not** be contacted by the Committee if they are excluded from the draw as a result of, for example, their bank not authorising payment. It is the responsibility of the buyer to ensure that payment has been made.

**Cash Purchases:** Tickets can be purchased in cash up to 10 days before the draw.

**Disputes:** The decision of the Bugbrooke Community Lottery committee shall be final and binding in any matter requiring adjudication.

**Data Protection:** Personal data is collected for the purposes of the Bugbrooke Community Lottery and will not be used for any other purpose or shared with any other 3<sup>rd</sup> party without the participant's express permission. Each participant will have the right to request a copy of their personal details held by Bugbrooke Community Lottery, or to ask us to delete their personal data, at any time. In the event of winning a prize, the participant must notify us, in advance, if they do not wish their name to be published.

**Registration:** Bugbrooke Community Lottery is registered with the Local Authority as required by the Gambling Act 2005.
